POSITION: COUNSELOR

QUALIFICATIONS:

Be at least 18 years of age, and a full year beyond high school.

Interest in working in an outdoor environment with campers who are children, and with adult and child campers who have special needs.

RESPONSIBLE TO:

- A. Skyline Executive Director & Program Director

GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

- A. Leadership and guidance of a group of two to twelve campers.
- B. Participate in general planning of camp program.
- C. Care and occasional counseling for campers needs

SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES:

- A. Live with a group of campers and help each camper grow and adjust to other campers and camp life.
- B. Assist campers with activities of daily living, as needed.
- C. Maintain safety and health requirements.
- D. Guide the individual camper in participation in group, unit and all-camp activities.
- E. Participate in program activities and other activities in the camp.
- F. Assist with all-camp program activities and other activities as assigned.
- G. Act as host/hostess at a table in the dining room.
- H. Assist in supervising, encouraging Junior Counselors
