Skyline is located on the east side of Michigan, about an hour north of Detroit. 156 acres of hills, woods and fields, including the highest point in Lapeer County.







Our summer staff is a size that allows everyone to know everyone, and we draw from a few different places so you're bound to meet some interesting folks and make some enduring friendships.

We add you to the staff Facebook group. Information is shared there, but also be sure to check your email for other things you need to do.

Flights and visas are handled by the staffing agency (e.g. Camp America). Keep in touch with them in your country to make sure that process moves along.

Keep us posted if you run into any worries or hurdles, so we can advocate for you with the staffing agency

Between now and summer, you fill out a few forms - some are information to help us plan the summer, others are policies you need to read, others are tax & employment forms. We will guide you to where these are (mostly in your CampInTouch account, which we can help you log into).

So we can pay your pocket money, we'll need you to have/create a PayPal account, and recommend that you link it to a credit card that you'll be travelling with.

Once you're on the journey, make sure you pass along any flight time changes. We will meet you at the airport and bring you to camp.

All good!
We're here to help you have a great experience, which in turn helps our campers have a great experience, so make sure you let us know how we can answer your questions and have you feel as comfortable as you can.

A few days after arrival, we need to take you to get a Social Security card. (This means you might get taxed, but you'll likely be able to get that back later).
