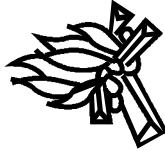




Skyline Unplugged!

All meals will be served by Skyline in the K&D

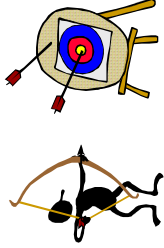


FRIDAY

Arrive Friday afternoon or evening and set-up camp. No meals are served on Friday. The program kicks off with a campfire on Friday evening.

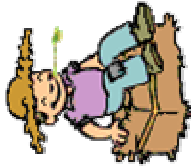
Most of our meals over the weekend will be locally grown and produced!

Come hungry!



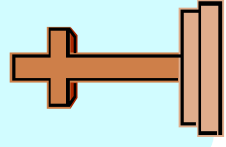
SATURDAY
